Scope of Service

1. **Review** the current, choose and apply the new modified system of hospital reporting and data collection
 2. Provide **support to the MoH/NHS in evidence-based decision making** necessary for implementation of the payment system based on AR-DRG modification
 3. **Develop the hospital payment system** which is based on DRG case-mix payment, identify necessary legal adjustments, and provide support to the MoH/NHS in development and improvement of the relevant regulatory framework

Scope of Service (cont.)

4. **Support implementation** of the DRG-based payment system and ensure its monitoring in 100 pilot hospitals
 5. **Conduct trainings** for health financing policy makers, staff of the National DRG Center, regional DRG centers, doctors, statisticians and economists of the pilot hospitals
 6. **Plan and implement a relevant communication campaign** which has to ensure development of understanding of the need to implement a DRG system among the reform participants and support of this process on their side

Training

Training for health financing policy makers:

- a) Primary workshop for health financing policy makers;
- b) Workshops on a quarterly basis for health financing policy makers where the current results of implementation of the action plan would be presented and further steps regarding the introduction of the DRG-based payment system will be discussed.

Number of participants – **30 persons**, location – Kyiv.



Training (cont.)

Training for employees of the National DRG Center and representatives of the respective units of the MoH:

- a) Initial 5-day training on hospital financing, DRGs in general, classifications, coding, audit of hospitals and costing;
 - b) First 5-day study tour to a country where an Australian DRG system (AR-DRG) is implemented;
 - c) 5-day training on coding and use of software products developed under the project;

Training (cont.)

Training for employees of the National DRG Center and representatives of the respective units of the MoH:

- d) Advanced 5-day training on hospital contracting and costing;
- e) Advanced 5-day training on classifiers, coding, and hospital audit;
- f) Second 5-day study tour to the county where an Australian DRG system (AR-DRG) is implemented.

Number of participants - ***at least 20 persons***, location - Kyiv



Training (cont.)

Train the staff of regional DRG centers and other stakeholders at the regional level:

- a) Initial 5-day training on hospital financing, DRG in general, classifications, grouping, audit of hospitals and costing;
- b) 5-day training on coding and use of software products developed under the project;
- c) Advanced 5-day training on hospital contracting and costing determination;
- d) Advanced 5-day training on classifiers, coding, and hospital audit.

Total number of participants – ***at least 150 persons***, maximum number of participants per each training cycle – 25 persons, location to be determined by the Consultant.



Training (cont.)

Training of trainers – for pilot hospital doctors:

- a) Initial 5-day training on DRG in general, classifiers and coding (focusing on classifiers and coding);
- b) Advanced 3-day training on classifiers and coding.

Total number of participants – ***at least 500 persons***,
maximum number of participants per each training cycle –
25 persons, location to be determined by the Consultant)



Training (cont.)

Training of trainers – for statisticians and economists of pilot hospitals:

- a) Initial 5-day training on DRGs in general, costing and use of software for DRG reporting/invoicing and hospital level analysis;
- b) Advanced 3-day training on costing and use of hospital software for DRG reporting/invoicing and hospital level analysis.

Total number of participants – ***at least 200 persons***, maximum number of participants per each training cycle – 25 persons, location to be determined by the Consultant)
